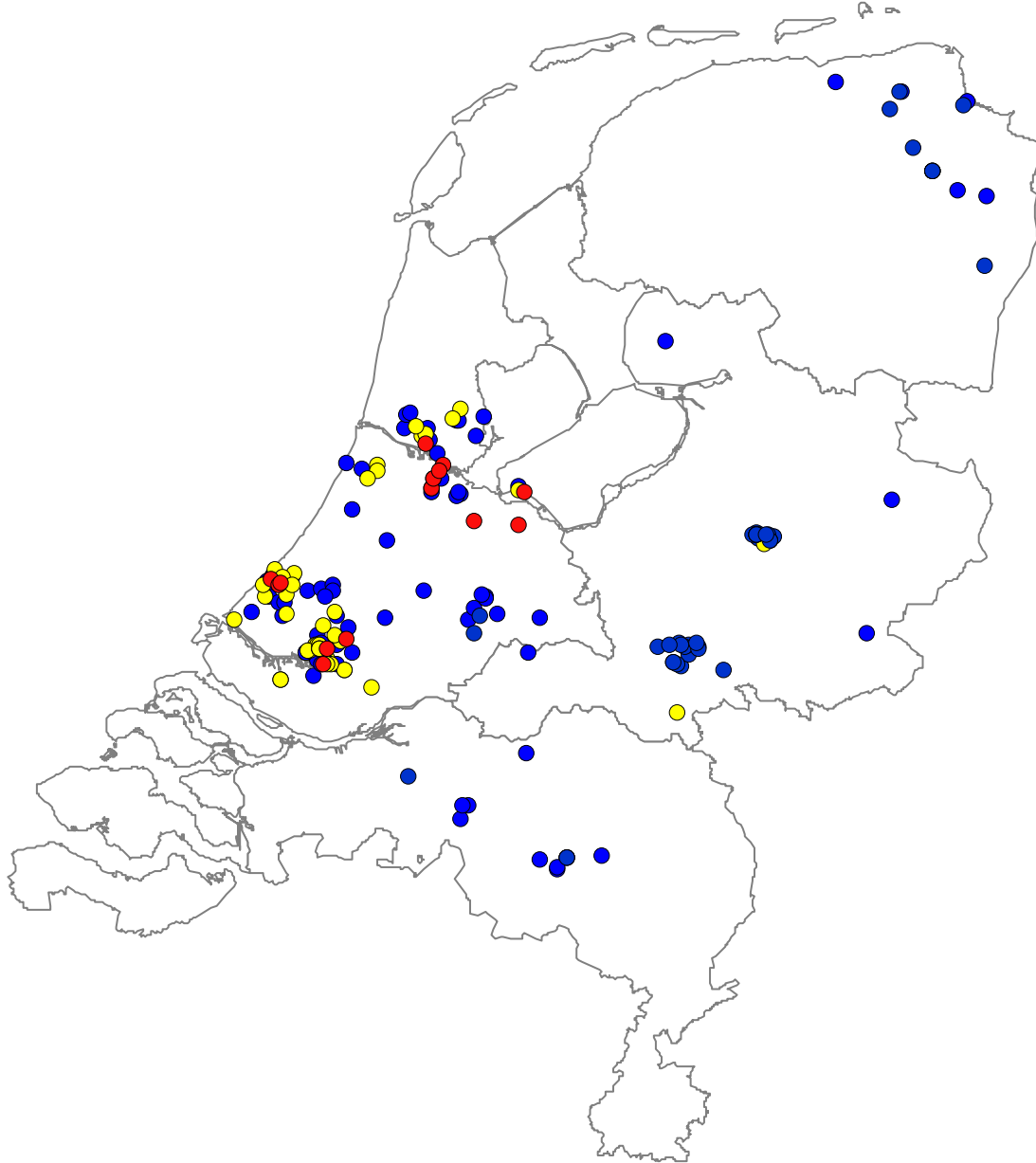

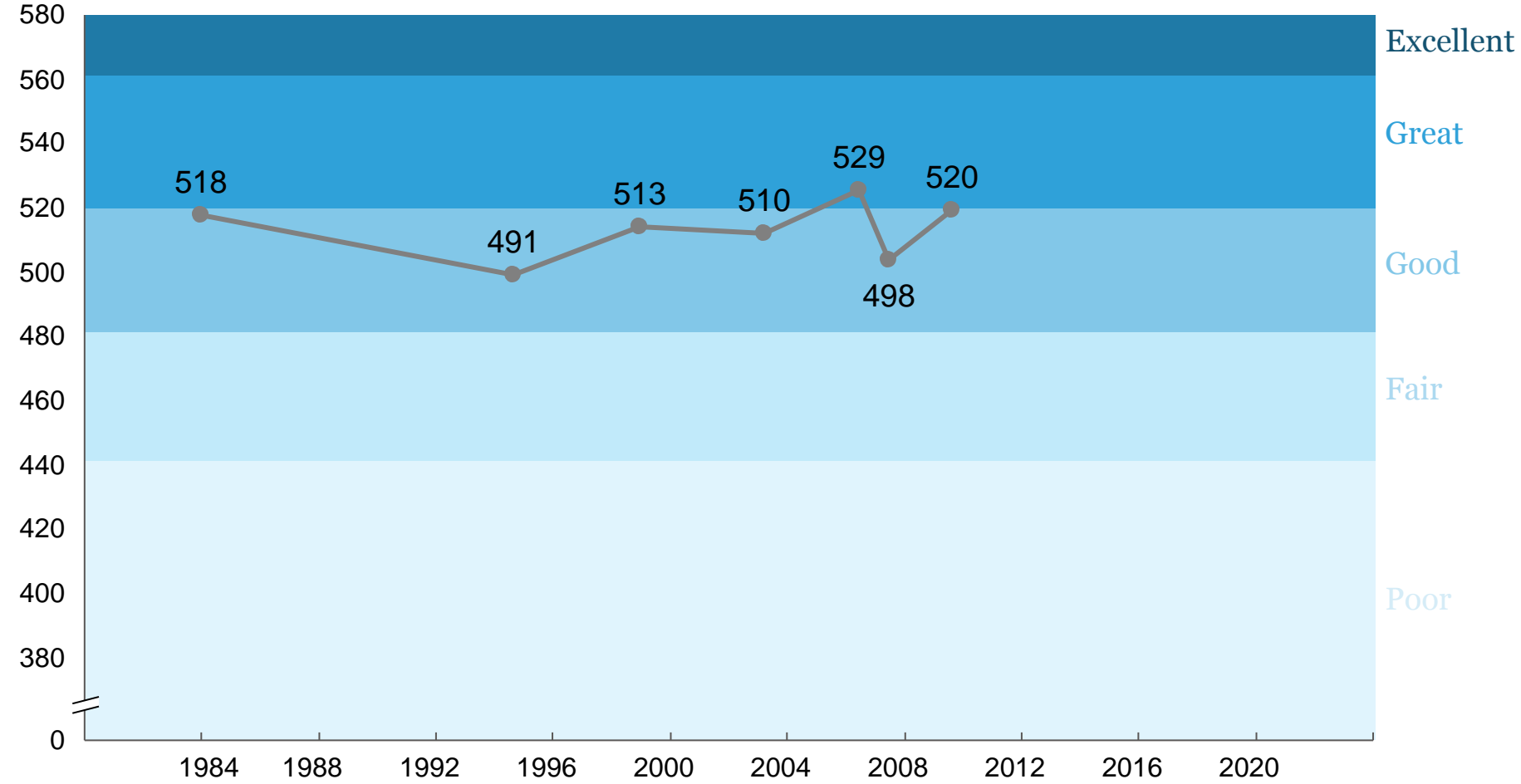

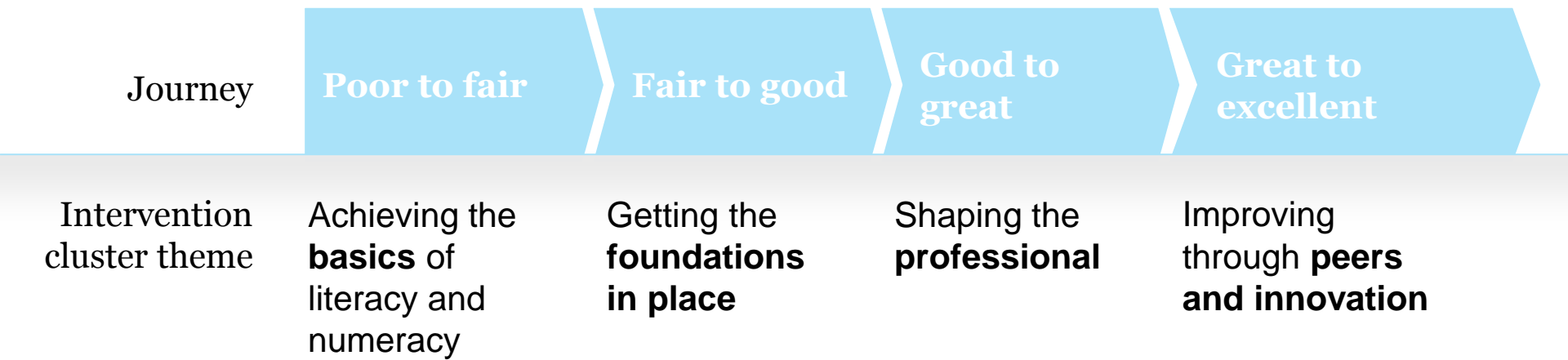
What Works? – We’re not doing something wrong, but we’re not getting better either...

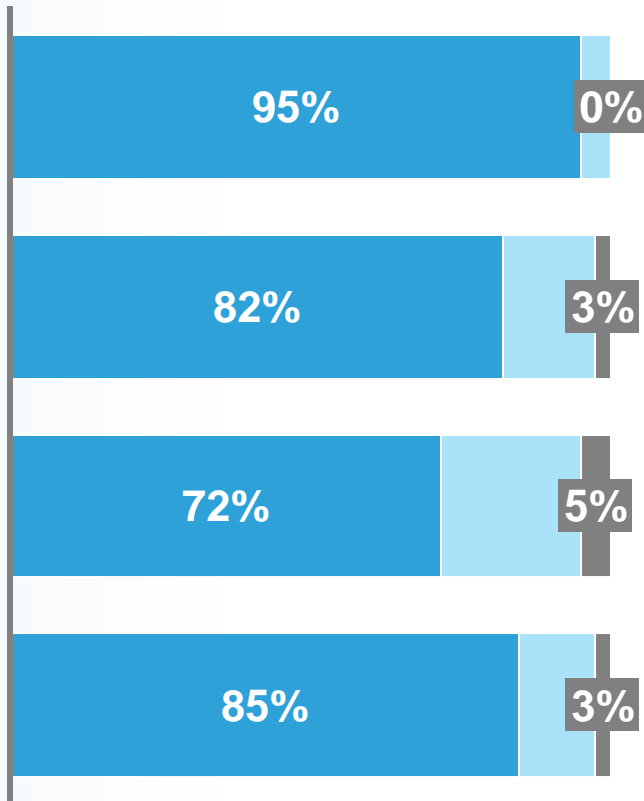
